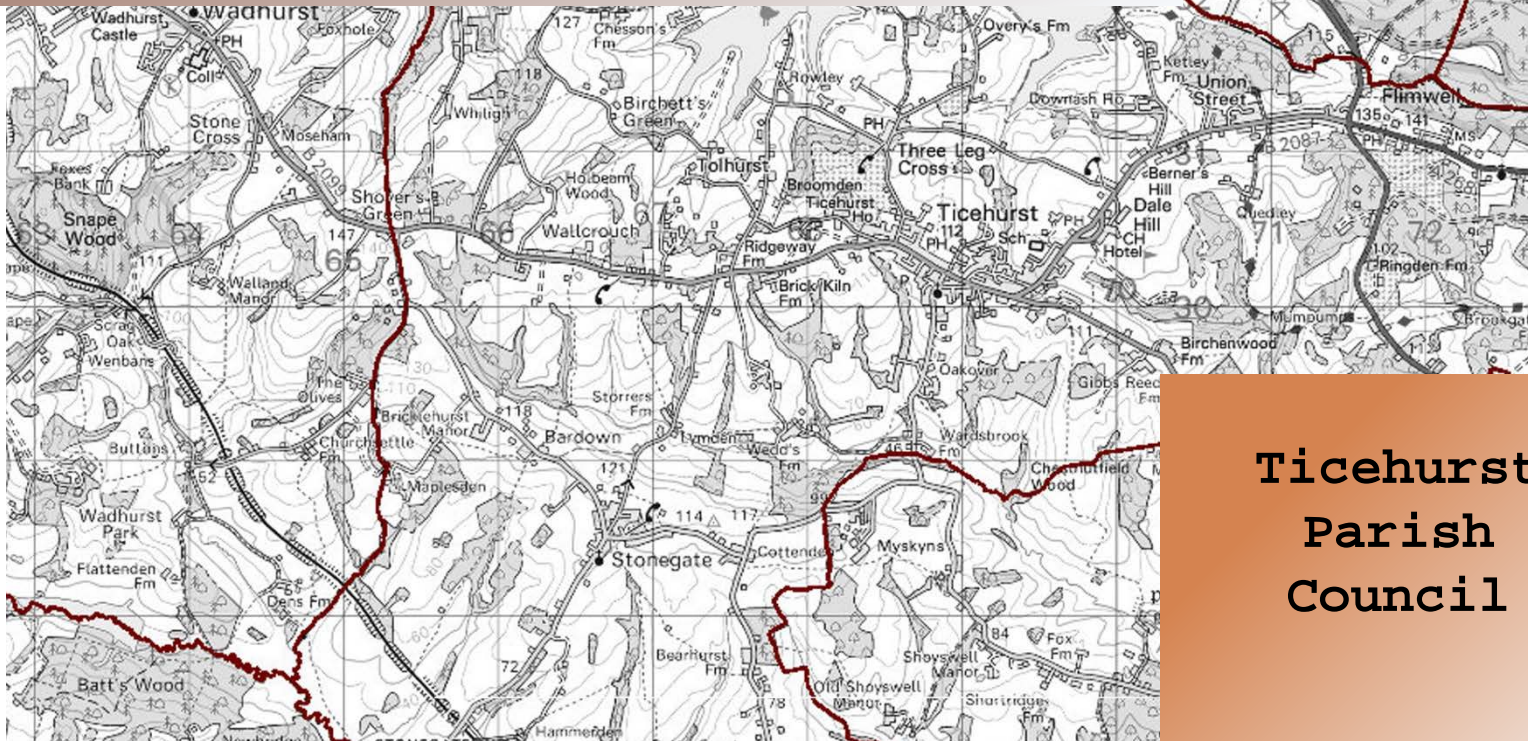

# Traffic Triffic!! A load of bollards!

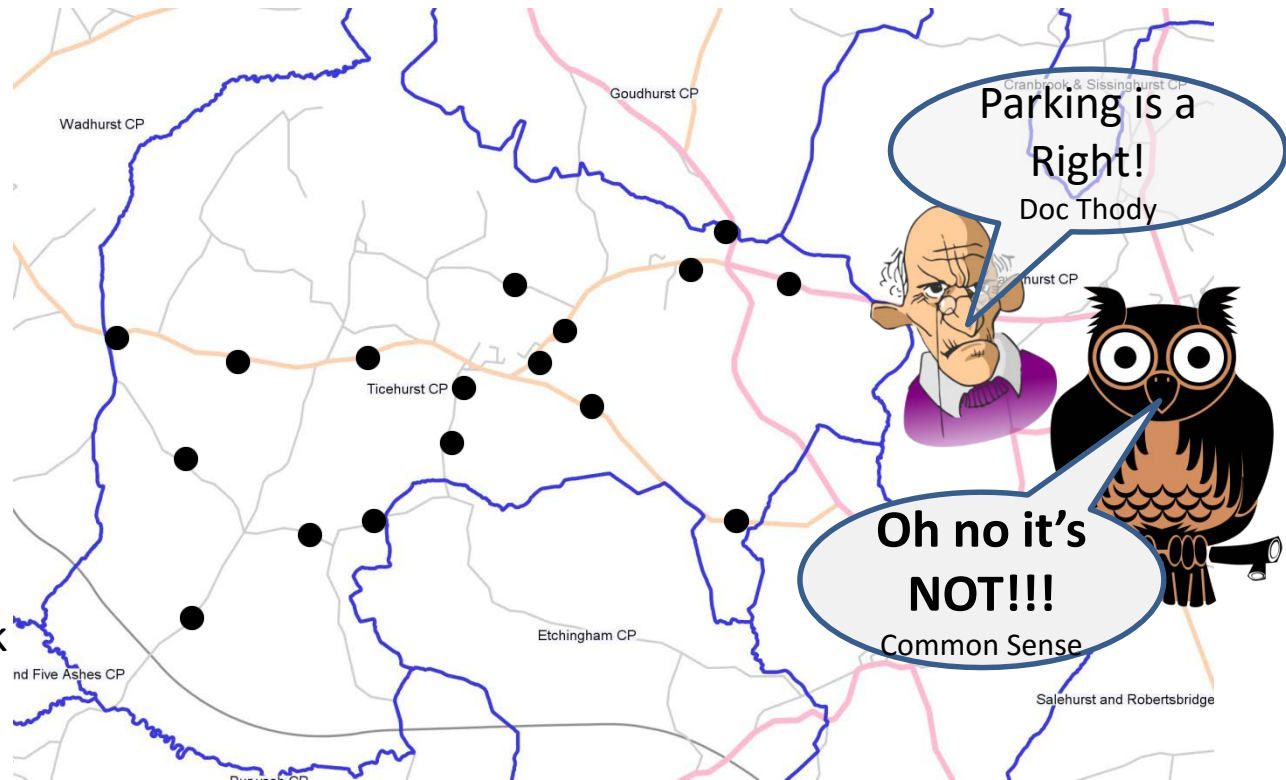
**The Challenge:** To make roads user-friendly for walkers, cyclists, horse-riders, push-chair passengers, mobility scooter drivers, residents, visitors and tourists.

## **Options:**

- Bollards, bollards everywhere!
- Speed display signs
- Speed cameras for enforcement

## **Limits:**

- 50 mph on A-roads
- 40 mph on B-roads
- 20 mph in villages and on minor roads
- **Represents** speeding black spots



## **Highway Code Rule 244**

You **MUST NOT** park partially or wholly on the pavement in London, and should not do so elsewhere unless signs permit it. Parking on the pavement can obstruct and seriously inconvenience pedestrians, people in wheelchairs or with visual impairments and people with prams or pushchairs.
