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# Our Neighbourhood Planning Experience



## Yalding, Kent

We are working with the local community to develop a range of new policy ideas for the emerging neighbourhood plan. New recreational links to the wider countryside are likely to be a key issue.



## Milborne St Andrew, Dorset

We devised a “PLACE” audit to help the neighbourhood plan group understand the historic settlement patterns and how to best respond to new development pressures.



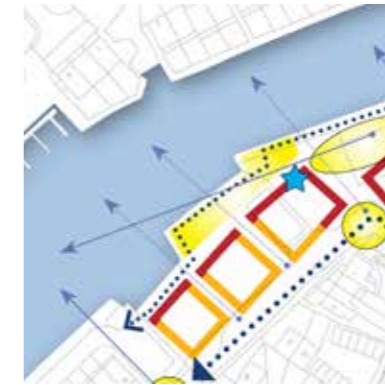
## Paddock Wood, Kent

We are advising the town council on the preparation of a neighbourhood plan that will need to accommodate up to 1,000 new homes and substantial new infrastructure works.



## East Street, Southampton

We worked with the city council, businesses and local traders to develop fresh ideas to revitalise this city centre shopping street. The resulting action plan is now being used to enable change.



## Faversham, Kent

Acting on behalf of Faversham Town Council, we steered this complex neighbourhood plan through public consultation and examination. It has been approved for referendum.



## Knowle West, Bristol

We worked with a neighbourhood forum group to test ideas for improved public realm, better access to green spaces and new street furniture outside the local primary school.



## Ticehurst, East Sussex

We are working with the businesses and local communities in the villages of Ticehurst, Flimwell and Stonegate to generate policy ideas and design guidance. The plan will go to pre-submission in early 2017.



## Hawkhurst, Kent

The plan for Hawkhurst has recently been submitted to Tunbridge Wells Borough Council and is currently at examination stage. The village sits within the High Weald Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB).



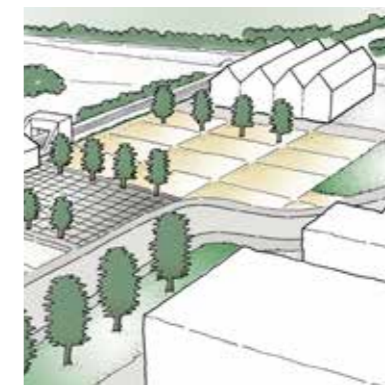
## Lewes, East Sussex

We have been commissioned to produce neighbourhood plan for this historic market. The plan will need to accommodate 220 new homes within the sensitive landscape of the South Downs National Park.



## Loose, Kent

We worked with the parish council to develop a landscape-led neighbourhood plan, addressing concerns about design in the countryside. The plan is currently out for its pre-submission consultation.



## Staplehurst, Kent

This plan addresses how up to 650 new homes can be accommodated in the parish. We were involved from the outset and the plan was approved at referendum in November 2016 with an overwhelming 93% YES vote.



## Joint Parishes Group, Kent

We worked with a coalition of twelve parish councils south of Maidstone to develop an alternative spatial strategy. This challenged the local plan's approach to new development in villages and other rural areas.

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
